<u>Motion Two:</u> by Kevin Gish that the Town accept the Rikert Property from the VT River Conservancy at no cost to the Town and per the terms of the Conservation Easement and Management Plan. Second by Mary Gavin. Motion carried 2-0-0 (Pettengill absent).

Follow-up discussions included the agreement among parties that the Selectboard would warn discussions annually in October for modifications to the Management Plan. The

Town will reach out to Mike Clark from Royalton to extend the invitation to continue to cut hay. Mary Russ suggested that a future meeting with Mike would be in order, due to the plan to establish a footpath to the river in addition to a small parking area.
