Policy Governing Access to Town Sand Pile

The Town of Sharon purchases and stores sand and salt for application to roadway surfaces as an integral part of its winter road maintenance program.

It is the intent of this policy to balance the need to preserve sand and salt supplies and protect the public safety, while providing Sharon residents and taxpayers reasonable access to sand for application to the driveways and entrances to their property to make them safer in difficult winter conditions.

<u>Primary Stockpile – Unavailable to Taxpayers:</u>

Due to concerns regarding personal and vehicular safety, <u>no</u> person or persons other than authorized Town personnel shall access the sand pile <u>inside</u> the gate at the entrance to Sharon Town Garage. This policy applies regardless of whether the gate is locked or unlocked and open.

Secondary Stockpile – Outside garage gate; Vehicle Loading Policies:

Sharon Road Crew will maintain a secondary sand pile that is located <u>outside</u> the gate to Sharon Town Garage for use by Sharon residents and taxpayers for <u>non-commercial use</u>. Residents and tax payers shall load their own vehicles. Town sand is not for resale.

Sharon Road Crew will replenish this secondary sand pile to the extent supplies, labor and equipment are available, and weather conditions permit.

ONLY authorized Town personnel shall have access to and use Town equipment. Use of Town equipment to load sand for private use is prohibited.

Salt Stockpile – Prohibited Access

Residents do NOT have access to the Town's salt pile.
