BID ADDENDUM NO. 1 Issued April 12, 2021

- 1. Amend <u>page 2</u> Paragraph 3 to read "<u>Bids shall be submitted on the **two-page** bid response form provided</u>. Bids must be accompanied by the required bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the lump sum bid amount, exclusive of ledge removal and tree removal."
- 2. Amend <u>page 6</u> "Bonds" paragraph one to read "The amount of the Bid Bond shall be five percent (5%) of the **lump sum bid amount**, exclusive of ledge removal and tree removal."
- 3. **Replace pages 10-11 bid response form** with "Revised Bid Response Form" as attached to this bid addendum.
- 4. Box culvert dimensions: As clarified by Stream Alteration Engineer Scott Jensen "Fisheries has agreed to waive the AOP requirement for this culvert. That means that the size of the culvert will be 6 feet wide and 3 feet high without needing embedment or Estone fill." (per email to Town of Sharon 4/5/21)
- 5. There are no guardrail requirements for this project.
- 6. Stream alteration permit issuance is conditioned upon acceptance by the State of approved specifications for the box culvert.
- 7. Town of Sharon town staff will begin the process of obtaining the Stream alteration permit and US Army Corps CAT 2 permits in mid-April. Successful bidder will need to assist the Town with obtaining final permits.
