BID ADDENDUM NO. 1 Issued April 12, 2021

1. Amend page 2 Paragraph 3 to read “Bids shall be submitted on the **two-page bid response form** provided. Bids must be accompanied by the required bid bond **in the amount of five percent (5%) of the lump sum bid amount, exclusive of ledge removal and tree removal.**”
2. Amend page 6 “Bonds” paragraph one to read “The amount of the Bid Bond shall be five percent (5%) of the **lump sum bid amount, exclusive of ledge removal and tree removal.**”
3. **Replace pages 10-11 bid response form** with “Revised Bid Response Form” as attached to this bid addendum.
4. Box culvert dimensions: As clarified by Stream Alteration Engineer Scott Jensen “Fisheries has agreed to waive the AOP requirement for this culvert. That means that the size of the culvert will be 6 feet wide and 3 feet high without needing embedment or E-stone fill.” (per email to Town of Sharon 4/5/21)
5. There are no guardrail requirements for this project.
6. Stream alteration permit issuance is conditioned upon acceptance by the State of approved specifications for the box culvert.
7. Town of Sharon town staff will begin the process of obtaining the Stream alteration permit and US Army Corps CAT 2 permits in mid-April. Successful bidder will need to assist the Town with obtaining final permits.
