A Town Plan provides a community vision and a basis for that vision. The Town Plan applies to all lands in the Town.

The Plan includes an inventory of the economic and demographic forces that have shaped, and will continue to shape, Sharon's identity. Its goals and policies for housing, public facilities, and transportation infrastructure, and for management and conservation of energy, recreational, scenic, historic and natural resources help to guide growth and development within the Town. Due to the absence of zoning in Sharon, the Town Plan affects the issuance of Act 250 permits. The Town Plan provides the context within which future bylaws will be adopted.
