



Temporary Signs on Municipal Property Policy

The Town of Sharon Selectboard has determined that the placement of temporary signs shall be allowed on municipal property.

Effective November 21st, 2022, the following rules apply:

- Anyone wishing to place temporary signs on municipal property will need permission from the Selectboard.
- Requests must be submitted in writing 5 days in advance of a regular meeting. The Selectboard holds regular meetings on the 1st and 3rd Monday of each month.
- All signs must be freestanding, with the exception of banners, which must be displayed using the Town Banner Display.
- Signs may be no larger than 12 square feet except in the case of a banner. Banners must be sized to fit the Town Banner Display
- All signs must be in good condition.
- Not more than two signs per organization or event shall be allowed on municipal property at a time.
- Signs may not be on display for more than two weeks. After two weeks, signs must be removed, or they may be disposed of by the Town.
- Signs will be placed in accordance with Vermont State law.
- Signs shall not create a danger to pedestrians, nor shall they not obstruct sight lines for drivers and cyclists.
